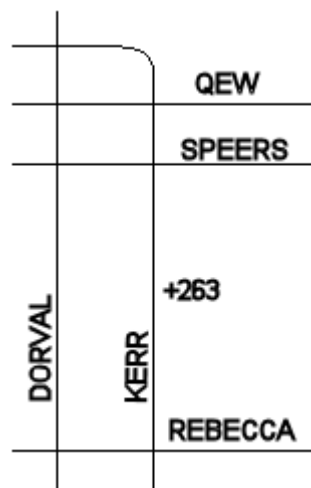
## CLUB FEES

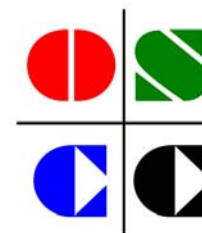
